RAISED \$100,000!**

In celebration of the 20th anniversary of the Ben Myers Ridge a Thon we sought to launch a new winter festival event that would take our commitment to support our community to new heights. We launched the Taos Community Foundation Winter Fund Fest as part of a three-year ramp up program that would serve as the umbrella for several fun winter activities – designed to develop stronger relationships and significant financial support for local non-profits in our community.

This year seven nonprofit teams participated along with independent skiers and boarders each raising funds supporting community health. Every organization received a 50 percent match through a grant from TCF.

Demonstrating their dedication to support Taos Community Foundation as the premier facilitator of philanthropy in our community, Taos Ski Valley and Chevron served as our major sponsors. They were joined by Cid’s Food Market, Volkl, Mogul Medicine, and more than 20 individual challengers, and 50 business sponsors. In our first year, the event broke even; we raised match dollars and prizes. It was amazing.
