# BLAKE MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP

#### Available to graduating Taos or Western Colfax County seniors

The scholarship is available to those applying to 4-year colleges and universities, as well as 2-year vocational or trade schools. The award is \$1,000, renewable for up to 3 years, if a 3.0 GPA is maintained. Applicants (or their parent/guardian) must be currently employed with TSV, Inc. or was employed for at least 1 ski season.

## BEATRICE T. AND VIRGIL D. GUTIERREZ LEGACY SCHOLARSHIP

## For graduating Taos High School seniors only

Est. in 2018 by the children of Beatrice T. & Virgil D. Gutierrez, a couple who devoted their lives to teaching in Taos Public Schools. The scholarship is available for students who plan to pursue advanced studies in math, science, or education by attending a 4-year college or university. The Fund will also consider students applying to a 2-year vocational or trade school. The award is \$3,500, renewable up to 4 years, if a 3.0 GPA is maintained.

## MANUEL & FILLIE GARCIA HISPANIC SCHOLARSHIP

## Awarded to Hispanic students graduating in Taos or Western Colfax County

The scholarship is available to students applying to 4-year colleges and universities, as well as 2-year vocational or trade schools. The award amount will be determined at the time of committee review. These awards can be renewable up to 3 years, if a 3.0 GPA is maintained.
