


FINANCIAL HIGHLIGHTS

Our work depends on strong financial management and solid internal operations. Taos Community Foundation continues to demonstrate a strong financial platform. Assets have grown over 70% in the last year alone. The financial statements of Taos Community Foundation are audited annually by an independent accounting firm. COMMUNITY IMPACT

We continue to position ourselves to define our work with the goal of creating community impact with a broader vision and a deeper commitment. Taos Community Foundation is not just a grantmaking organization. We see ourselves as a leader in building trusting relationships with individuals, businesses and organizations, so that together we create lasting positive change.

Our 2020-21 Community Leadership work began with a commitment to explore partnership in a wider circle. The unparalleled crisis of COVID-19 brought the need for collective power and partnered resources to a whole new level. A few of the leadership partnerships this year have included:

THE FUND FOR TAOS — The opening of our Emergency Action Fund in 2020, offered the charitable vehicle for donors to contribute directly to COVID relief/recovery efforts. Implementing a rapid-response application review process and volunteer advisors, the Foundation awarded nearly \$600,000 in just 7 months to nonprofits in our area. The total granted for COVID relief efforts is well over \$900,000.

FEMA / EMERGENCY RESOURCES -

In continued partnership with the Enchanted Circle-Communities Active in Disaster (EC-COAD) group, over \$3 million has been received in community for a wide variety of emergency support needs in our region. The Foundation has been the charitable partner in the endeavor providing tax contribution documentation when appropriate.

LARGER PHILANTHROPIC FOOTPRINT

IN THE REGION — Efforts this year brought strong partnerships with several private foundations, resulting in both matching grant opportunities as well as platforms for discussions on emerging community initiatives. Topics of Housing, Homelessness and Broadband are just a few of the dedicated leadership conversations the Foundation embarked on. These conversations represent dedicated involvement on both a regional and statewide collaborative level.



As our assets and partnerships grow, so does our ability to increase our grantmaking activities. Through various initiatives, the Foundation supports charitable projects through both competitive grant application cycles as well as matching donors with things that spark a personal passion or interest. We strive to find the points of intersection that bring new resources, talents and expertise to the table.
