- FIELD OF INTEREST FUNDS

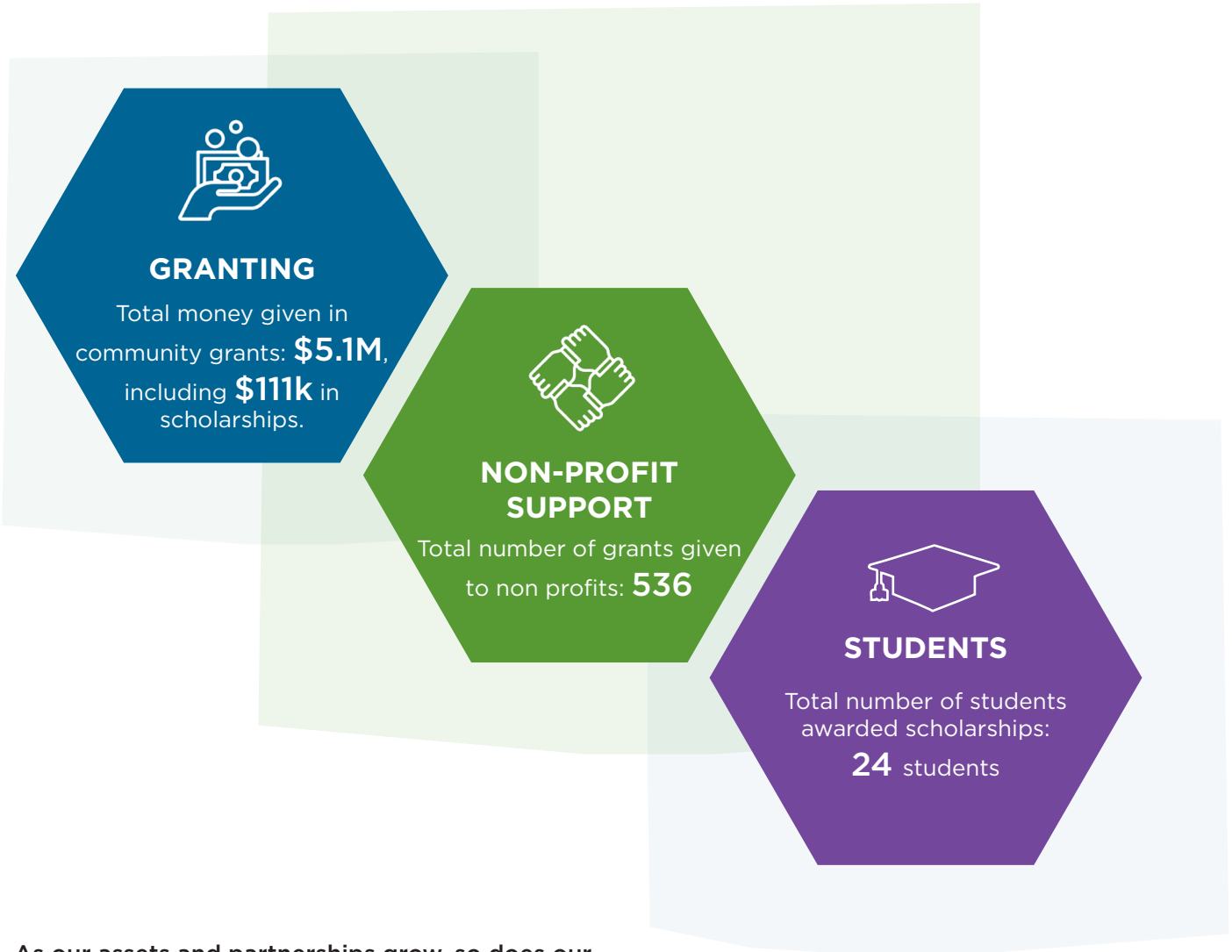
